In John 3, Jesus speaks most clearly about reincarnation with Nicodemus, including 3:17 which most Christians ignore. Here is a summary of reincarnation in the New testament:

The Bible available to us today does not explain reincarnation in great detail, but there are a number of clear references to it. Looking at the many passages surrounding the second coming of Elijah (Mal. 4:5, Matt. 16:13-14 and 17:10-13, Mark 9:11-13, Mark 6:14-16, John 1:19-21), one gets the impression that reincarnation was a common belief at the time the Bible was written from all of these comments about someone being born

again and the longing for a Prophet to come again. This would explain why there is not much detail on it, since one does not have to elaborate on concepts that are common knowledge.

Nicodemus was concerned about his ability to change at such a late stage in his life when he asked Jesus: "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus' answer was: "Most assuredly." In John 3:1-21, Jesus is telling an old man, who had just heard the teachings of Jesus, that clearly he did not have enough years left to change his ways, but that through God's Love he would have at least another life in which he could live according to these new teachings.

Modern genetic research confirms that it was impossible for any human to live to the ages quoted in the Old Testament. Genetic research done on human remains confirms that there has been no change in the human body over this time period. Genesis 5:5 says: "So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died." This is not the same as saying Adam lived to be 930 years old. Saying that his total years on Earth were 930 reconciles modern scientific knowledge with the Bible. It also helps to properly place biblical events into both geological and archeological history since Adam's 930 years could have been scattered over a 10 to 20 thousand-year time span.

The eruption of the volcano Santorini (on the island of Thera, north of Crete) in 1646 BC, has helped historians to accurately date Joseph's life. The volcanic ash fallout from this eruption most likely caused the 7 years of famine, and which forced Jacob and his family to travel south to Egypt. Based on this, Jacob-Israel died around 1627 BC.2 At the same time, archeologists have placed Abram's life in the 22nd century BC. It does not take super-human life spans to explain the missing 400 years in this family history when you consider the possibility of multiple lives.

Intuitively, it is hard to believe that it was the same Jacob who so easily stole his older brother's first- born right, but later, so patiently put up with many years of abuse in order to win the daughter of Laban. It is also hard to believe that the great hunter Esau let his brother get away with such a dirty trick. It is more likely that he tracked down and killed Jacob for his treachery shortly after he discovered it. This means that the Jacob-Israel who woke up in Genesis 28:18 did so 400 years later, in a new life on Earth, and with a stronger belief in God. This logically explains Jacob's 147 years on Earth, after dying in his 80's in Egypt. It also helps to explain how Esau's family got so big in what was earlier thought to have been a short period of time.

And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because  $the \, sun \, was \, set; \, and \, he \, took \, of \, the \, stones \, of \, that \, place, \, and \, put \, them \, for \, his$ pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep. And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it. And, behold, the Lord stood above it, and said, I am the Lord God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed; And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed. And, behold, I am with thee, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done that which I have spoken to thee of. And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely the Lord is in this place; and I knew it not. And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is this place! this is none other but the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it. (Genesis 28:11–18)

Genesis 28 is where the 400 years were lost. This is a good example of

The He did not say the *spirits*, He said The Spirit. (Singular, personal)

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever- John 14:17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

There are many of case of false ideas from His disciples, but John understood Him the best, that's why Jesus loved him most.

There is no error or false ideas in the Bible. The Holy Spirit (the Spirit of Truth) was instrumental in what every apostle believed and taught and wrote. (1 Corinthians 2).

It never says Jesus loved him the most. He said he was beloved by Jesus. John was perhaps as young as 16–18 during Jesus's ministry. Jesus likely thought of him as a younger brother. John understood Him because Jesus included him in His inner circle with Peter and James.

In John 3, Jesus speaks most clearly about reincarnation with Nicodemus, including 3:17 which most Christians ignore.

John 3 is about the gospel and about salvation through faith in Jesus. 3:17 is about the gospel. Reincarnation is NOT the same thing as physical **Resurrection**. This happens only once in the last day.

It's also NOT the same thing as **Spiritual Rebirth**. (**Regeneration**) or being **Born Again**. This means that the old spirit in a person has died and the Holy Spirit has taken up residence inside the person. They have been spiritually made alive by having God inside of them. They have been *spiritually* born again. This happens by repentance (symbolized by baptism/water), faith in Jesus (gospel), and being born of the Spirit.

Here is both Peter and John (before they died) talking to first century Christians.

1 Peter 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

1 John 3:9 No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God.

And John in his gospel: John 1:12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God-

- John 1:13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

The Bible available to us today does not explain reincarnation in great detail, but there are a number of clear references to it. Looking at the many passages surrounding the second coming of Elijah (Mal. 4:5, Matt. 16:13-14 and 17:10-13, Mark 9:11-13, Mark 6:14-16, John 1:19-21),

These are talking about the final physical resurrection of all the living and the dead. The exception is when it's talking about a ROLE, rather

than a person. When the prophet Elijah comes in the person of John the Baptist it's not talking about the person, it's talking about their *spiritual role*. John was also a spiritual herald proclaiming repentance and announcing another to come after (Jesus).

Nicodemus was concerned about his ability to change at such a late stage in his life when he asked Jesus: "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus' answer was: "Most assuredly." In John 3:1-21, Jesus is telling an old man, who had just heard the teachings of Jesus, that clearly he did not have enough years left to change his ways, but that through God's Love he would have at least another life in which he could live according to these new teachings.

He was not saying that he would have another life to change but that, by the power of God, He would be changed. Through the gospel we are changed and become born again. In the final resurrection we receive our final bodies and are glorified. But there are only three states. The original that dies, soul/spirit with no body in either Heaven or Hades, and eternal body/soul/spirit in either Heaven or Hell.

Again this is speculation. These are your ideas rather than what God has said in His Word. It is "more likely" that Jesus didn't die and rise again. It is "more likely" that Paul stayed a murderer of Christians and never became a powerful apostle of Christ. But this is the power of God! Trust in God's promises and in His Word rather than speculation and ideas of men!

This means that the Jacob-Israel who woke up in Genesis 28:18 did so 400 years later, in a new life on Earth, and with a stronger belief in God. This logically explains Jacob's 147 years on Earth, after dying in his 80's in Egypt. It also helps to explain how Esau's family got so big in what was earlier thought to have been a short period of time.

If you're going to not believe in half of the Bible why believe in the other half? Is God not trustworthy? Why believe Esau had a big family at all, or that he even existed? Why not just trust God that Jacob lived supernaturally longer than genetically normal because it was part of God's plan for him?

Genesis 28 is where the 400 years were lost. This is a good example of how God plays an active role in people's lives. Jacob had gone astray in his life. Rather than let him continue in the wrong direction. God ended his life (he took the ladder to Heaven). His spirit went to Heaven where he relearned his mission on Earth and then was reborn 400 years later as the ethical man we know as Jacob-Israel.

Or, Jacob had a real encounter with the living God and it changed him dramatically! He had his dream and it changed him. And then on his way home he had the encounter with God (who many scholars believe was a pre-incarnate Jesus) in the cave. And he wrestled with Him. And that is why He changed Jacobs name to Israel which means "he who wrestles with God." (Genesis 32:24–30)

Other passages that confirm that being born again happens in this life when you give your life to Jesus:

By James. James 1:18 He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created.

By Paul. Galatians 4:5 to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship. Galatians 4:6 Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." Galatians 4:7 So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir.

And Paul again here. Ephesians 1:5 he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will
Ephesians 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, Ephesians 1:14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession--to the praise of his glory.

By John again. 1 John 4:4 You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

I pray that the spiritual eyes of your heart would be opened. Take hold of the promise of God and receive a guarantee of eternal life! Right now in this life! And also know that the Spirit of God may be your possession, that you may know God intimately and receive Him in your very being to be an eternal treasure both in this life and forever. God bless.
